21st Century Parks Adds Five to Steering Committee

Louisville, Ky.— 21st Century Parks, the nonprofit organization leading the creation and management of a new, 4,000-acre public parks system along the Floyds Fork watershed, has added five new members to its capital campaign steering committee.

The new committee members are: Bernie Fineman, chief executive officer, Caldwell Tanks; Alex Gift, account executive, The Underwriters Group; James Clay Smith, president, Central Bank-Louisville; Glenn Sullivan, president, The Sullivan University System; and Hunter Wilson, Executive Vice President, Papercone Corporation.

“We are pleased to welcome these new additions to our steering committee and are grateful for their willingness to help make history in our community,” said Dan Jones, Chairman and CEO of 21st Century Parks. “The support of local business leaders is essential in our efforts to create world-class parklands along Floyds Fork.”

To date, the 40-plus member steering committee has helped 21st Century Parks raise \$90 million toward a \$110 million goal for land acquisition and parkland development. Construction is expected to begin later this year.

leading the creation and management of a new, 4,000-acre public parks system along the Floyds Fork watershed in eastern and southeastern Louisville. The new parks system is one of the largest and most ambitious metropolitan park projects in the nation.
